Terms and Conditions
(Unless otherwise specified)

1. **General:** When Elephant Butte Irrigation District issues a purchase order in response to the bid, a binding contract is created. By signing the bid, vendor agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid that will be incorporated into the resulting contract.
2. **Variation in Quantity:** No variation in the quantity of any item called for by this order will be accepted unless such variation has been caused by conditions of loading, shipping, packing or allowances in manufacturing process and then only to the extent, if any, specified in this order.
3. **Assignment:**
 - a. Neither the order, nor any interest therein, nor any claim thereunder, shall be assigned or transferred by the Contractor, except as set forth in Subparagraph 3b or as expressly authorized in writing by Elephant Butte Irrigation District. No such assignment or transfer shall relieve the Contractor from the obligations and liabilities under this order.
 - b. Contractor agrees that any and all claims for overcharge resulting from antitrust violations which are borne by the State as to goods, services, and materials purchased in connection with this bid are hereby assigned to Elephant Butte Irrigation District.
4. **Discounts:** Prompt payment discounts will not be considered in computing the low bid.
5. **Inspection:** Final inspection and acceptance will be made at the destination. Supplies rejected at the destination for nonconformance with specifications shall be removed at the Contractor's risk and expense, promptly after notice of rejection.
6. **Inspection of Plant:** Elephant Butte Irrigation District may inspect, at any reasonable time, the part of the Contractor's, or any subcontractor's plant or place of business, which is related to the performance of this contract.
7. **Commercial Warranty:** The Contractor agrees that the supplies or services furnished under this order shall be covered by the most favorable commercial warranties the Contractor gives for such to any customer for such supplies or services. The rights and remedies provided herein shall extend to Elephant Butte Irrigation District and are in addition to and do not limit any rights afforded to Elephant Butte Irrigation District by any other clause of this order. **Contractor agrees not to disclaim warranties of fitness for a particular purpose of merchantability.**
8. **Taxes:** The unit price shall exclude all state taxes and freight
9. **Packing, Shipping and Invoicing:**
 - a. Using agency purchase order number and the Contractor's name, user's name and location shall be shown on each packing and delivery ticket, package, bill of lading and other correspondence in connection with the shipments. The user's count will be accepted by the Contractor as final and conclusive on all shipments not accompanied by a packing ticket.
 - b. The Contractor's invoice shall be submitted duly certified and shall contain the following information: purchase order number, description of supplies or services, quantities, unit price and extended totals. Separate invoices shall be rendered for each and every complete shipment.
 - c. Invoices must be submitted to the using agency, Elephant Butte Irrigation District, 530 S. Melendres, Las Cruces, NM 88005. Otherwise shipment and invoices are to other qualified units of government, including cities, counties, school districts, institutions of higher education and other jurisdictions not subject to the procurement authority of the State Purchasing Agent who are authorized to purchase under the terms of this contract.

10. **Default:** Elephant Butte Irrigation District reserves the right to cancel all or any part of this order without cost to Elephant Butte Irrigation District, if the Contractor fails to meet the provisions of this order and, except as otherwise provided herein, to hold the Contractor liable for any excess cost occasioned by Elephant Butte Irrigation District due to the Contractor's default. The Contractor shall not be liable for any excess costs if failure to perform the order arises out of causes beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the Contractor, such causes include but are not restricted to, acts of God or the public enemy, acts of the State or Federal Government, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes, unusually severe weather and defaults of subcontractors due to any of the above, unless Elephant Butte Irrigation District shall determine that the supplies or services to be furnished by the subcontractor were obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit the Contractor to meet the required delivery scheduled. The rights of Elephant Butte Irrigation District provided in this paragraph shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights now being provided by law or under this order.

11. **Non-Collusion:** In signing this bid the Contractor certifies he/she has not, either directly or indirectly, entered into action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with this offer submitted to Elephant Butte Irrigation District.

12. **Nondiscrimination:** Contractor doing business with Elephant Butte Irrigation District must be in compliance with the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Title VII of the Act (Rev. 1979) and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336).

13. **The Procurement Code:** Sections 13-1-28 through 13-1-199 NMSA 1978, imposes civil and criminal penalties for its violation. In addition the New Mexico criminal statutes impose felony penalties for bribes, gratuities and kickbacks.

14. **Items:** All bid items are to be NEW and of most current production, unless otherwise specified.

15. **Payment for Purchases:** Except as otherwise agreed to: late payment charges may be assessed against the user state agency in the amount and under the conditions set forth in Section 13-1-158 NMSA 1978.

16. **Workers' Compensation:** The Contractor agrees to comply with state laws and rules pertaining to Workers' Compensation benefits for its employees. If the Contractor fails to comply with Workers' Compensation Act and applicable rules when required to do so, this Agreement may be terminated by the contracting agency.

17. **Submission of Bid:** Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the bid number and opening date clearly indicated on the bottom left hand side of the front of the envelope. Failure to label bid envelope will necessitate the premature opening of the bid in order to identify the bid number.

18. **Contractor Personnel:** Personnel proposed in the Contractor's written bid to the Procuring Agency are considered material to any work performed under this Price Agreement. Once a Purchase Order or contract has been executed, no changes of personnel will be made by the Contractor without prior written consent of the Procuring Agency. Replacement of any Contractor personnel, if approved, shall be with personnel of equal ability, experience, and qualifications. The Contractor will be responsible for any expenses incurred in familiarizing the replacement personnel to insure their being productive to the project immediately upon receiving assignments. Approval of replacement personnel shall not be unreasonably withheld. The Procuring Agency shall retain the right to request the removal of any of the Contractor's personnel at any time.

19. **Subcontracting:** The Contractor shall not subcontract any portion of the Price Agreement without the prior written approval of the Procuring Agency. No such subcontracting shall relieve the Contractor from its obligations and liabilities under this Price Agreement, nor shall any subcontracting obligate payment from the Agency.

20. **Records and Audit:** The Contractor shall maintain detailed time and expenditure records that indicate the date, time, nature, and cost of services rendered during this Price Agreement's term and effect, and retain them for a period of three (3) years from the date of final payment under this Price Agreement. The records shall be subject to inspection by the Agency, State Purchasing Division and Department of Finance and Administration. The Agency shall have the right to audit billings, both before and after payment. Payment for services under this Price Agreement shall not foreclose the right of the Agency to recover excessive or illegal payments.

21. **Subcontracts:** The foregoing requirements for Contractor Personnel, Subcontracting, and Audit shall be inserted into all subcontracts from the prime contractor to the subcontractor.

Failure of Bidder to complete bidding documents, in accordance with all instructions provided, is cause for Elephant Butte Irrigation District to reject their bid.

Brand names and numbers are for reference only; equivalents will be considered. If bidding “equivalent” bidders must be prepared to furnish “complete data” upon request, preferably with bid, to avoid delay in award.

Specifications on the bid are not to exclude any bidder or manufacture. Where a brand name or equal is indicated, it is for the purpose of describing the standard of quality, performance and characteristics desired and is not intended to restrict competition. “No substitute” specifications may be authorized ONLY if required to match existing equipment.

If any Bidder is of the opinion that the specifications as written preclude him from submitting a bid on this ITB, it is requested that his opinion be made known to Elephant Butte Irrigation District, in writing, at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date.

Bidders must, upon request of Elephant Butte Irrigation District, provide information and data to prove that the financial resources, production of service facilities, service reputation and experience are adequate to make satisfactory delivery of the materials and/or services. Elephant Butte Irrigation District reserves the right to require a Bidder to furnish a Performance Bond prior to award, where the Bidder is unable to furnish the required information or data, or for other reasons which would insure proper performance by the Bidder.

Unless otherwise indicated in the bid specifications, samples of the items, when required, shall be free of expense to Elephant Butte Irrigation District. Samples not destroyed or mutilated in testing will be returned upon request, at Bidders expense. Each sample must be labeled to clearly show the bid number and item number that it pertains to. Unsolicited bid samples or descriptive literature, which is submitted at the Bidder’s risk, will not be returned.

Awards

Determination of Lowest Bidder – Following determination of product acceptability, if any is required, bids will be evaluated to determine which Bidder offers the lowest cost to in accordance with the specifications and terms & conditions set forth in the Invitation to Bid. Elephant Butte Irrigation District reserves the right to award this Invitation to Bid in total; by groups of items; on the basis of individual items; any combination of these which could result in a multiple award; or as otherwise specified in bid specifications; whichever, in his/her judgment, best serves the interest of Elephant Butte Irrigation District.

Elephant Butte Irrigation District reserves the right to accept and/or reject any and all bids, to waive technical irregularities, and to award to the Bidder whose bid is deemed to be in the best interest of Elephant Butte Irrigation District..

Special Notice – To preclude any possible errors and/or misinterpretations, bid prices must be affixed legibly in ink or typewritten. Corrections or changes must be signed or initialed by Bidder prior to the scheduled bid opening; failure to do so will be just cause for rejection of bid.

Bids may be withdrawn upon receipt of written request, prior to scheduled bid opening for the purpose of making any corrections and/or changes; such corrections must be properly identified and signed or initialed by Bidder. Resubmittal must be prior to scheduled bid opening for consideration.

After bid opening, no modifications on bid prices or other provisions of bid shall be permitted. A low Bidder alleging a material mistake of fact after bids have been opened may be permitted to withdraw the bid upon written request prior to award at the discretion of Elephant Butte Irrigation District.

F.O.B. Destination – Means goods are to be delivered to the destination designated by the user which is the point at which the user accepts ownership or title of the goods. Laws of New Mexico specifically prohibit acceptance of ownership of goods in transit. Any exception to F.O.B. Destination may cause bid to be declared nonresponsive.

New Mexico Employees Health Coverage

A. If Contractor has, or grows to, six (6) or more employees who work, or who are expected to work, an average of at least 20 hours per week over a six (6) month period during the term of the contract, Contractor certifies, by signing this agreement, to have in place, and agrees to maintain for the term of the contract, health insurance for its New Mexico Employees and offer that health insurance to its New Mexico Employees if the expected annual value in the aggregate of any and all contracts between Contractor and the State exceeds \$250,000 dollars.

B. Contractor agrees to maintain a record of the number of its New Mexico Employees who have (a) accepted health insurance; (b) declined health insurance due to other health insurance coverage already in place; or (c) declined health insurance for other reasons. These records are subject to review and audit by a representative of the state.

C. Contractor agrees to advise all of its New Mexico Employees of the availability of State publicly financed health care coverage programs by providing each of its New Mexico Employees with, as a minimum, the following web site link to additional information: <https://www.bewellnm.com/>.

D. For purposes of this Paragraph, the following terms have the following meanings:

- (1) “New Mexico Employee” means any resident of the State of New Mexico employed by Contractor who performs the majority of the employee’s work for Contractor within the State of New Mexico, regardless of the location of Contractor’s office or offices; and
- (2) “offer” means to make available, without unreasonable restriction, enrollment in one or more health coverage plans and to actively seek and encourage participation in order to achieve the goals of Executive Order 2007-049. This could include State publicly financed public health coverage programs such as *Insure New Mexico!*

Price Agreement

Article I – Statement of Work

Under the terms and conditions of this Price Agreement other government, including cities, counties, school districts, institutions of higher education and other jurisdictions not subject to the procurement authority of the State Purchasing Agent and allowed by law may issue orders for items and/or services described herein. The terms and conditions of this Price Agreement shall form a part of each order issued hereunder.

The items and/or services to be ordered shall be as listed under Article IX - Price Schedule. All orders issued hereunder will bear both an order number and this Price Agreement number. It is understood that no guarantee or warranty is made or implied by Elephant Butte Irrigation District or the user that any order for any definite quantity will be issued under this Price Agreement. The Contractor is required to accept the order and furnish the items and/or services in accordance with the articles contained hereunder for the quantity of each order.

Article II – Term

The term of this Price Agreement, for issuance of orders, shall be as indicated in the specifications.

Article III – Specifications

Items and/or services furnished hereunder shall conform to the requirements of specifications and/or drawings applicable to items listed under Article IX-Price Schedule. Orders issued against this schedule will show the applicable Price Agreement item(s), number(s), and price(s); however they may not describe the item(s) fully.

Article IV – Shipping and Billing Instructions

Contractor shall ship in accordance with the following instructions: Shipment shall be made only against specific orders which the user may place with the Contractor during the term; The Contractor shall enclose a packing list with each shipment listing the order number, price agreement number and the commercial parts number (if any) for each item; Delivery shall be made as indicated on page 1. If contractor is unable to meet stated delivery Elephant Butte Irrigation District, or the using agency must be notified.

Article V – Termination

Elephant Butte Irrigation District may terminate this Agreement for convenience or cause. The Contractor may only terminate this Agreement based upon the Agency's uncured, material breach of this Agreement. Contractor shall give Agency written notice of termination at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination, which notice shall (i) identify all the Agency's material breaches of this Agreement upon which the termination is based and (ii) state what the Agency must do to cure such material breaches. Contractor's notice of termination shall only be effective (i) if the Agency does not cure all material breaches within the thirty (30) day notice period or (ii) in the case of material breaches that cannot be cured within thirty (30) days, the Agency does not, within the thirty (30) day notice period, notify the Contractor of its intent to cure and begin with due diligence to cure the material breach. Termination of this Contract, however, shall not affect any outstanding orders. This provision is not exclusive and shall not waive other rights and remedies afforded either party in the event of breach of contract or default. In such instances the contract may be cancelled effective immediately.

Article VI – Amendment

This Price Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of Elephant Butte Irrigation District and the Contractor upon written notice by either party to the other. An amendment to this Price Agreement shall not affect any outstanding orders issued prior to the effective date of the amendment as mutually agreed upon, and as published by Elephant Butte Irrigation District. Amendments affecting price adjustments and/or the extension of a price agreement expiration date are not allowed unless specifically provided in the bid and price agreement specifications.

Specifications:

Establish a Price Agreement for corrugated metal pipes, bands and ends.

The term of this Price Agreement shall be for one (1) year from date of award with the option to extend for a period of three (3) additional years, on a year-to-year basis, by mutual agreement of all parties and approval of Elephant Butte Irrigation District at the same price, terms and conditions. This Price Agreement shall not exceed four (4) years.

Corrugated metal pipe, bands and end sections must meet the requirements of Section 570 of the Standard Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction, 2014 Edition found at: <http://dot.state.nm.us/content/nmdot/en/Standards.html>. The pipe shall be helically corrugated with re-rolled, annular ends. Helically corrugated pipe shall have two and two thirds (2 2/3) inch x half (1/2) inch; three (3) inch x one (1) inch; or five (5) inch x one (1) inch as required by standard serial BMC-001-03.

All corrugated metal pipe shall be supplied in twenty (20) foot sections, twenty-four (24) foot sections or thirty (30) foot sections as ordered and specified by the using agency.

Pipe dimensions up to forty-eight (48) inches in diameter shall have a delivery time of maximum three (3) days ARO. Special order larger sizes shall have a delivery time of maximum four (4) weeks ARO.

Shipping Note: Prepay freight and add to invoice as a separate item for any other destination.

Within fifteen (15) days after the date the using agency receives written notice from the Contractor that payment is requested for services, construction or items of tangible personal property delivered on site and received, the using agency shall issue a written certification of complete or partial acceptance or rejection of the services, construction, or items of tangible personal property. If the using agency finds that the services, construction, or items of tangible personal property are not acceptable, it shall, within thirty (30) days after the date of receipt of written notice from the Contractor that payment is requested, provide to the Contractor, a letter of exception explaining the defect or objection to the services, construction, or delivered tangible personal property along with the details of how the Contractor may proceed to provide remedial action. Upon certification by the using agency that the services, construction, or delivered tangible personal property have been received and accepted, payment shall be tendered to the Contractor within thirty (30) days after the date of certification. If payment is made by mail, the payment shall be deemed tendered on the date it is postmarked. After the thirtieth (30th) day from the date that written certification of acceptance is issued, late payment charges shall be paid on the unpaid balance due on the contract to the Contractor at the rate of one and one half percent (1-1/2%) per month. For purchases funded by state or federal grants to local public bodies, if the local public body has not received the funds from the federal or state funding agency, but has already certified that the services or items of tangible personal property have been received and accepted, payments shall be tendered to the Contractor within five (5) working days of receipt of funds from that funding agency. Final payment shall be made within thirty (30) days after the work has been approved and accepted by the using agency.

The Contractor agrees to comply with state laws and rules pertaining to Worker's Compensation Insurance coverage for its employees. If Contractor fails to comply with the Worker's Compensation Act and applicable rules when required to do so, the Price Agreement may be cancelled effective immediately.

Quantities are estimates; exact usage shall be determined by the using agency.
